Only female mosquitoes bite.

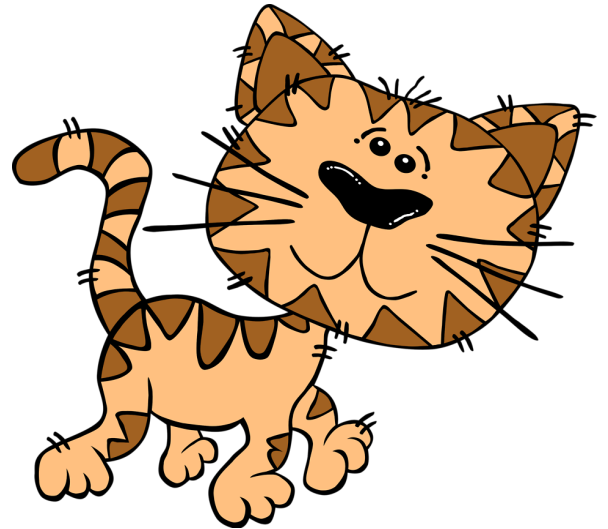
Polar Bear skin is black.

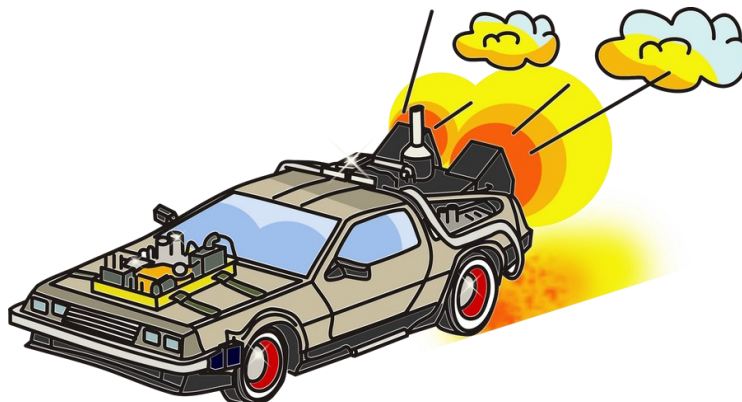

DECENT STUFF

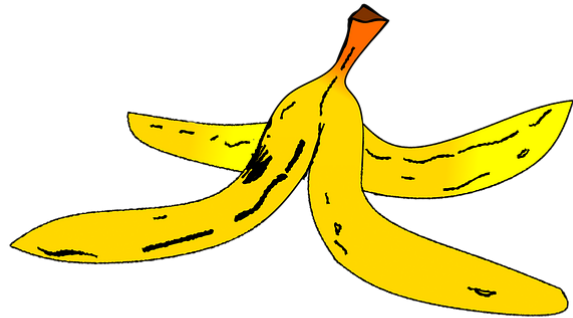

Weird Trends

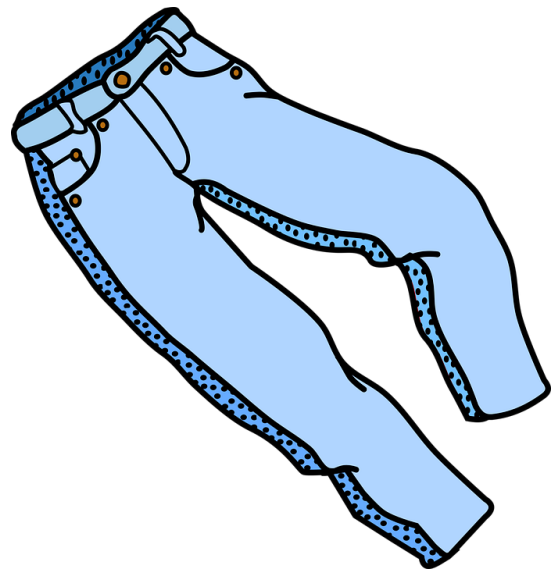
