Expect the worst!

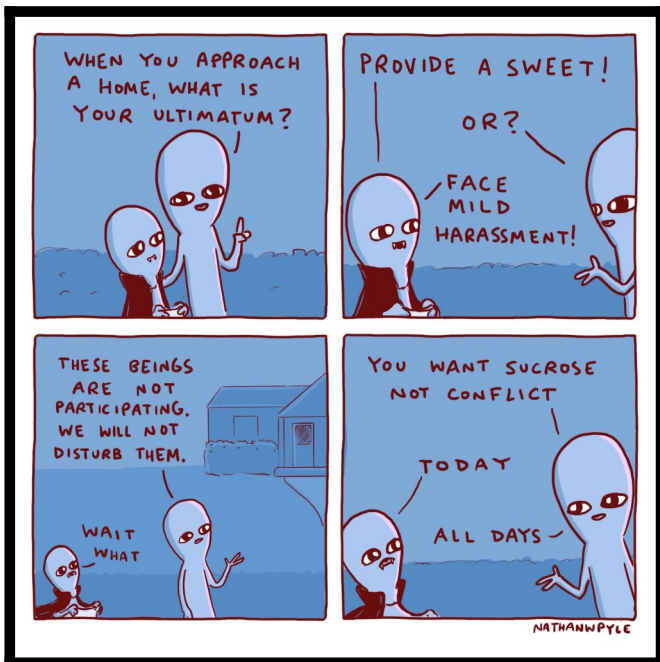


The best part about Halloween
