Dear Principal Jaggi,

Over the past several years, Hall Park has experienced numerous incidents of vandalism. The resulting property damage, repair costs, and additional cleanup time have placed an unfair burden on the citizens of Hurricane. Hurricane Middle School students account for the majority of the incidents related to this issue.

I have met on several occasions with the School Resource Officer, the Parks Department, and concerned citizens to review the ongoing issues, associated costs, and potential solutions. Based on these discussions—and at the recommendation of the School Resource Officer, the Parks Department, and approval from the mayor we have determined that Hall Park will be off limits to middle school students from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

We respectfully request your assistance, along with that of your staff, in informing students of this restriction and helping monitor compliance to ensure that students do not enter park property during these hours. The School Resource Officer and patrol officers will also monitor the area and take appropriate action if necessary.

It is unfortunate that this action has become necessary; however, it is an important step in maintaining the health, safety, and welfare of the community, as well as preserving the park for residents to enjoy.
